The grouse of the petitioner is that two applications filed by him in appeal pending before Deputy Commissioner – cum – Appellate Authority, Panchkula under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007, have not yet been decided by the said Appellate Authority, which may cause prejudice to his rights in the property in dispute.
