On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/respondent No.1 and raises no objection.

Mr. Anupam Singla, Advocate, who is also present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/respondent No.2 and he also raises no objection.

In view of the fair stand taken by learned State Counsel as well as learned Counsel for respondent No.2 and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

On oral request of learned Counsel for the parties, main case is preponed and taken on board today itself.

MAIN CASE

Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to reinstate/reappoint the petitioners as EGS/AIE Volunteers.

Concededly, claim of the petitioners is satisfied, therefore, learned Counsel for the petitioners does not press the petition any more.

Ordered accordingly.

Disposed off.

Since main writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed, therefore, the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
