Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 26.08.2021 (P-5), whereby the respondents have fixed the cut-off marks (67.25) on the basis of written test (first stage) for Backward Class Category, more than the last General Category i.e. 65.25, for the posts of Revenue Patwari, Irrigation Booking Clerk (Patwari) and Ziladars.

This Court, vide order dated 03.09.2021, granted interim relief in the same terms as in CWP No.17131 of 2021 and as such, the petitioner was provisionally allowed to participate in the written examination (second stage) for the post(s) in question subject to the final outcome of the writ petition(s).

Thereafter, on 03.11.2021, respondents were directed to produce the result of the petitioner in a sealed cover.

Today, in compliance of above order, result of the petitioner has been produced in a sealed cover and the same is opened.

Perusal of the result reveals that petitioner is lower in merit than the cut-off marks fixed for Backward Class Category by the respondent-Board in the written exam (second stage).

Faced with the above situation, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner does not want to press the present petition on merits; rather wishes to withdraw the same.

Ordered accordingly.

Result of the petitioner is re-sealed and returned to the official concerned, present in Court.
