The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 46, dated 29.01.2019, lodged under Sections 498-A, 323, 354-A, 377, 506/34 of IPC (later on Sections 354-A and 34 of IPC deleted), registered at Police Station Dabua, Faridabad, District Faridabad (Haryana).

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, to which the parties were referred to, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement. The same has also been reduced into writing and placed in the case file.

In terms of the compromise entered between the parties, a demand draft in the sum of Rs. 3.00 lakh, has been handed-over to the learned counsel for the complainant in Court today, against proper receipt.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in terms of

the compromise, is going to be filed before the family Court concerned very shortly.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 (complainant) does not dispute the factum of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties as well as the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner in Court today.

Learned State counsel pleads no objection.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, the petition is allowed subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
