The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.112 dated 30.10.2019 at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 324, 323 & 34 IPC, wherein offence under Section 326 IPC was added subsequently. It has today been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that in fact offence under Section 201 IPC has also been added thereafter.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties and a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise i.e. CRM-M-54536-2019 has already been filed in this Court.

3. Learned State counsel has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have been compromised and the petitioner has already joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 05.10.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
