Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail', upon FIR no.399, dated 30.5.2017, having been registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 186/307/332/353/34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

On 22.2.2021, the following order had been passed by this court:-

“Case heard by video conference.

Though the co-ordinator of this video conference has informed me that learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to connect to the video conference, however learned State counsel submits that, as per his instructions from SI Rish Parkash, though some of his co-accused have been convicted,

the petitioner himself, i.e. Aman, has been acquitted.

However, counsel for the petitioner not being present, adjourned to 24.02.2021.
