HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed by accused-petitioner, against whom the FIR No.74 dated 10.03.2021 under Section 388 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Safidon, District Jind, has been registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present FIR has wrongly been registered against the petitioner to pressurize him as he had submitted a complaint against the complainant, on the basis of which, FIR no.74 dated 10.03.2021 has been registered. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR is not being investigated properly, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner, for which the petitioner has already filed a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Jind dated 31.03.2021

(Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration with the said authority

and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioner in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-4), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-4), within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
