AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 17 dated 6.7.2021, under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (as amended by Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018) and Section 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Patiala.

This Court vide order dated 6.9.2021, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Inspector-Ranjit Kaur submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating. She further submits that the petitioner be asked to join the investigation again as his voice sample is to be taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that voice sample would be given on the date fixed i.e. 25.11.2021.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail

granted on 6.9.2021 is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, in case the petitioner does not adhere to the statement with regard to giving of voice sample, the State would be at liberty to move an application for re-calling of the order.
