The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.86 dated 18.06.2019 registered under Section 420 of IPC at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 08.07.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. He submits that the petitioner has handed over a bank draft for an amount of Rs.1,65,000/- to the IO who has further handed over the same to the complainant-Gurdev Singh.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid facts that the petitioner has paid a bank draft of Rs.1,65,000/- which has been handed

over to the complainant and the petitioner has joined the investigation. He states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide dated 08.07.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
