The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.496 dated 04.11.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram, on the basis of compromise in the shape of an affidavit of respondent No.2 dated 14.11.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of an altercation between neighbours in which simple injuries were caused. He also contends that with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the affidavit of respondent No.2 at Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 contends that matter has indeed been compromised.

This Court, vide order dated 06.09.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements and send a report as to whether the compromise has been arrived at without any coercion or undue influence. The report of the JMIC, Gurugram dated 19.10.2021 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that compromise which has been effected is genuine, voluntary and without undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of an altercation between neighbours in which simple injuries were caused. He also contends that with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab 2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.496 dated 04.11.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram and all consequential proceedings are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
