Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner wants to live her life peacefully and respondent No. 4, who is the husband of the petitioner, is creating all kind of problems for her. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner, keeping in view the fact that her husband, namely, Balwinder i.e. respondent No. 4 was already married, which fact was not disclosed to her at the time of their marriage, she is living separately in Kurukshetra and respondent No. 4 is issuing all kinds of threats to her and the petitioner apprehends threat to her life and liberty at the hands of respondent No. 4 and hence, an appropriate direction be issued to respondents No. 1 to 3 to ensure that respondents No. 4 to 6 are not able

to harm the petitioner in any manner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance before respondent No. 2- Superintendent of Police, District Kurukshetra by filing representation dated 27.08.2021 (the date has been incorrectly typed as 02.08.2021) (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said complaint/representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 27.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 27.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present petition stands disposed of.
