The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.457 dated 11.08.2020 under Sections 120-B, 323, 354-A, 354-C, 354-D, 406, 420, 498-A and 509 IPC registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, District Panipat.

In compliance of order dated 22.09.2021, affidavit of the petitioner has been filed qua the extent of share holding which was held by the complainant in all his three companies prior to the year 2015 as also her present status as far as her share-holding is concerned. The same is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant has opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the wake of allegations levelled in the FIR in question. It has been

submitted that the petitioner had indulged in forging the signatures of the complainant as a result of which she incurred financial losses as well.

Learned State counsel while drawing the attention of this Court to the status report filed by way of affidavit of Sandeep Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Traffic, Panipat, has submitted that a thorough investigation was carried out and Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC stand deleted against the petitioner on 04.10.2020. She has further submitted that she has instructions to say that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. In addition, while drawing the attention of this Court to the reply filed, she has submitted that the petitioner already stands released by the police/investigating officer on furnishing adequate security bonds.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 07.10.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
