The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are major and they have married each other voluntarily but the private respondents have been opposing the marriage and, therefore, he has prayed for the protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners.

At this stage, Mr. Parampreet Singh Paul, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, Union Territory, Chandigarh has caused appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 only and has stated on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh that both the petitioners had already come to the police station and had rather recorded their statements that now the parents of the

petitioners have accepted the marriage and there is no threat from them.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for the withdrawal of the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
