The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.144 dated 08.05.2021, registered for offences under Sections 307, 324, 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and cross-version GD No.52 dated 11.05.2021, registered for offences under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Tripri, District Patiala and to add the relevant provisions under Sections 307, 452 and 295-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 in the cross-version.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that as is apparent from the photographs of CCTV cameras footage (Annexure P-2), which is in possession of the petitioner, respondents No. 4 to 11 were the aggressors and the version of the petitioners has been lodged as G.D.No. 52 dated 11.05.2021, however, proper investigation is not being conducted. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2, but the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to examine the representation dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as representation dated 28.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
