The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.115 dated 04.12.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sector 17, HUDA, Jagadhri, District Yamunanagar, on the basis of compromise dated 16.08.2021 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is outcome of a property dispute with regard to the execution of a Will. He also contends that with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

This Court vide order dated 24.09.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements

and send a report as to whether the compromise has been arrived at without any coercion or undue influence. The report of the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Yamunanagar dated 08.10.2021 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that compromise which has been effected is genuine, voluntary and without undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of a property dispute with regard to the execution of a Will which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab 2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.115 dated 04.12.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sector 17, HUDA, Jagadhri, District Yamunanagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
