HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed with a prayer that a direction be issued to respondents No. 1 to 4 for deciding the complaint, which the petitioner had filed against respondents No. 5 to 8 raising certain grievances with regard to the forging of Will supposedly executed by the father of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a complaint was made to the police, which has already been enquired into, wherein, the allegations have been substantiated. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that no action is being taken by the police despite the said substantiation of the allegations in the enquiry by the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the relief which has been claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 16.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) to

respondent No.2, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection for deciding the representation dated 16.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 16.06.2020 (Annexure P-1), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 16.06.2020 (Annexure P-1) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated if all the parties to the dispute are heard before passing the order.
