Application for replacing page No.18 in the paperbook.

For the reasons stated in the application, same is allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions and page No.18 is ordered to be replaced. Registry will do the needful.

Main case

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for directing respondent No.2 to revise the latest answer key dated 08.07.2021 (P-6) and further issue fresh answer key after considering the submissions and recognized study material.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioners, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied, in case, legal notice dated 20.07.2021 (P-8) is reconsidered by the

competent authority.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority, to reconsider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 20.07.2021 (P-8), in accordance with law by passing speaking order expeditiously, but not later than 15.10.2021.
