The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to ensure fair and impartial investigation with regard to a complaint dated 20.04.2021 filed by the petitioner against respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for her grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) to the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana i.e. Respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioner would be satisfied in case the said representation be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into

the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.
Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, to take a decision on the representation dated 06.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
