The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent to count qualifying service for grant of revised pensionary benefits with effect from the date they joined the Corporation instead of date of contribution to provident fund alongwith arrears and interest on delayed payments @ 18% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-5) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to

duly consider legal notice dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-5) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
