The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.04 dated 26.08.2020 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC at Police Station Women Cell, District Mohali.

Vide order dated 07.10.2020 passed by this Court, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and a report dated 24.02.2021 has been received from the Mediator.

As per report of the Mediator, the parties have settled their disputes by way of amicable settlement. The settlement/compromise deed dated 06.01.2021 is also attached with the report.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the settlement/compromise deed dated 06.01.2021 has been reduced into writing, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.10.2020 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

The petitioner shall not be arrested in the case unless a clear 15 days notice is given to him.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/compromise deed dated 06.01.2021 in letter and spirit.
