The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the inaction and direction to the respondents whereby arrears of salary on account of pay revisions after 7th Pay Commission and the amount of education allowance payable to the children of late Smt. Surinder Kaur, Science Mistress, is not being released to the petitioners.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on representation dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-9) of the petitioners, within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-9) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioners are found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioners within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
