Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.62 dated 15.06.2021 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC,1860 registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur. He apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 06.09.2021 whereby while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“The petitioner herein seeks the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.62 dated 15.06.2021 registered at Police Station Ghall Khurd, District Ferozepur, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 506, 148 & 149 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, contends that the petitioner is a young boy and he has been falsely implicated in this case and moreover, he is ready to join in the investigation as and when so

required and is also not involved in any other case of the similar nature.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurav Khurana, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, accepts the notice.

Let notice to respondent No.2 be issued for 10.12.2021 through e-mail or any other electronic mode. Dasti as well.

Meanwhile, in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing the requisite personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

However, the petitioner shall join in the investigation as and when required to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. He further states that the parties have also arrived at a compromise.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ASI Anwar Mashih does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.09.2021 is made absolute.
