Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of petitioner in view of Punjab Government Policies dated 04.03.1999 and 23.01.2001 (P-2 & P-3) and in view of judgments dated 23.09.2002 and 28.10.2014 rendered in CWP No. 12199 of 2000 and CWP No.1933 of 2014 (P-4 and P-5) respectively.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 05.07.2021 (P-7) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpret Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to

respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice (P-7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of three months from today.
