Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 10.08.2017 registered under Sections 307, 336, 341, 324, 148 and 149 IPC,1860 (Sections 302, 120-B, 201 read with Section 34 IPC added later on) and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 29 of Arms Act, 1959 added later on) at Police Station Bajakhana District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implication in the case in hand. He also submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 25.08.2017 and the trial has not yet concluded. Hence, the petitioner may be extended the concession of regular bail.

Per contra, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from SI Jaskaran Singh submits that the prosecution evidence stands concluded and now it is fixed for recording of statement under Section 313 Cr.PC.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, no ground is made out to extend the concession of regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
