Prayer in this application is for quashing of impugned order dated 21.12.2020 passed by learned trial Court whereby the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender vide Annexure P-26 in case FIR No.0103 dated 27.04.2019 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is out of India in connection of work and he would certainly come back and join the trial.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 and 3 submits that she would have no objection provided the petitioner files an affidavit before the trial Court mentioning the details of his bank accounts, demat accounts, immovable properties and value of sovereign cash in hand.

Given above, the present petition is allowed.

However, it is subject to condition that petitioner will appear before the trial Court on any date upto 28.02.2022. In case of any reason, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court till 28.02.2022, then the petitioner after giving valid reason/explanation will be permitted to appear on any date upto 11.03.2022, failing which this order shall automatically be recalled under Section 362 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. without any reference to this Court.

It is also clarified that this order is subject to petitioner filing the affidavit in the aforesaid terms.
