The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.201, dated 05.11.2018, registered under Sections 307, 353, 427, 212, 216, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Islamabad, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Submits *inter alia* that the Petitioner, who was already on bail could not appear before the Ld. Trial Court on 15th March, 2021 due to reasons beyond his control inasmuch as he was required to go to Delhi in connection with some urgent personal work and the application filed on his behalf for exemption on that date was dismissed.

3. Submits further that henceforth the Petitioner shall not miss the proceedings of trial, and his aforesaid lapse which otherwise due to reasons beyond his control, may be condoned.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Sewak, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the Respondent/State. A copy of the paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

6. After hearing both sides, the matter is disposed off with a direction upon the Petitioner to surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within one week from today, after which he shall be released on a fresh bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
