1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the instant petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order dated 05.04.2021 in case FIR No.0128 dated 14.10.2018 registered under Sections 420 and 120-B, IPC, at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran on account of non submission of final report before the concerned Magistrate within 3 months from the date of passing of the aforesaid order.
3. Notice of motion is yet to be issued in the instant case.
4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that now the respondents have concluded investigation and submitted cancellation report, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
