By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.97, dated 11.04.2021, having been registered at Police Station City Narwana, Jind, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 392/34 of the IPC and Sections 28/54/59 of the Arms Act (with Section 25 of the Arms Act deleted later).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for the past almost 8 months with the trial still not having been effectively commenced and with there being no other criminal case registered against him.

Upon query to learned State counsel he does not deny the factual position.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, with the petitioner ordered to be admitted

to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
