Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.128 dated 19.07.2021, under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 506, 509 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Panipat, District Panipat.

By virtue of the order dated 06.09.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Surinder has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
