Petitioners-HC/PR Jagjit Singh and 22 others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents department to step up the pay of the petitioners at par with Respondents No.13 to 16/their juniors in their own cadres in view of speaking order dated 17.09.2020 (Annexure P-10) passed by Department in pursuance of order dated 19.06.2020 passed by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No.8290 of 2020.

As per pleadings in the petition, for the above mentioned grievance, the petitioners have served a legal notice dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-8) to respondents No.1 to 16, but the same has not been decided till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ayush Sarna, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as contained in the legal notice dated 08.03.2021 (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case, the petitioners are found entitled on merits to the claim as raised in the legal notice, the same be disbursed within one month from the date of decision of the legal notice.

So ordered.
