The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* for direction to the respondent Nos.3 to 7 to decide the representation dated 01.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) with regard to release of pension alongwith other consequential benefits and service benefits alongwith interest @ 18% from the date of due till actual realization.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents pass a speaking order on representation dated 01.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, D.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 01.08.2021 (Annexure P-4) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
