Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.312 dated 31.08.2018 registered under Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Rajindra Park, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that after registration of the FIR, which was registered on the basis of a secret information, the petitioner was granted regular bail on 05.10.2018, however, he absented from the Court proceedings and later on, non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner and the petitioner due to mis-communication, could not appear before the trial Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail. It is also submitted that in another FIR No.641 registered under Section 326 IPC, the petitioner is already on bail and is appearing before the trial Court.

Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and argued that the petitioner is intentionally avoiding the appearance before the trial Court as despite issuance of the non-bailable warrants, the same are not being executed as he is avoiding the same.

After hearing the counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for fresh bail, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and the trial Court will release the petitioner on interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds and on payment of costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with the District Legal Services Authority, Gurugram.
