The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.950 dated 04.09.2016 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379, 427, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, “the IPC”) at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat to which Sections 324, 325 and 326 of the IPC were added lateron.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Malik, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Mr. Dinesh Saini, Advocate has put in appearance through Video Conferencing on behalf of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for both the petitioner and the complainant are ad idem that the dispute has been amicably resolved between the parties, which has also been recorded in compromise deed dated 24.08.2021

(Annexure P-3).

In such circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner would not appear to be called for. Therefore, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, he shall be released on anticipatory bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
