This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 to file a status report with regard to FIR No.289, dated 30.07.2021, under Sections 148/ 149/ 323/ 354-A/379-B, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner herein would contend that the FIR was registered against respondents No.4 and 5, who belong to the ruling party, with the allegations that they had snatched a gold chain and also made obscene acts after entering the house of the petitioner herein. However, no action has been taken on the said FIR.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. She, on instructions from Station House Officer

Satish Kumar, would submit that in fact the matter has been investigated and

a cancellation report has been prepared on 20.08.2021 and the same is pending approval.

In view of aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, this Court finds that the instant petition seeking status report, has been rendered infructuous, leaving it open to the petitioner to avail an appropriate remedy in accordance with law in case she is not satisfied with the cancellation report.
