By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.59, dated 09.03.2019, having been registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 82 of the Registration Act, 1908.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 16.09.2021, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, submits that the petitioner in this petition has joined investigation and presently at least her custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, whatsoever, since the investigating agency itself does not require the custodial interrogation of the petitioner, this petition has in fact been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, she would be

given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon her.
