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**JAISHREE THAKUR, J. ( ORAL )**

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.124 dated 02.07.2020 under Section 341, 307, 452, 354, 323, 325, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend false implication in the said matter. It is submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 15.08.2021 and the only role attributed to the petitioner is of slapping the mother of the complainant and of inflicting danda blows. It is further submitted that the matter has been investigated and challan though ready is yet to be presented and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, therefore, prays for concession of bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State would oppose grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature and the challan though ready is yet to be

presented.

I have heard counsel for the parties and have also perused the FIR which reflects that the only role attributed to the petitioner herein is of slapping the complainant's mother and of inflicting danda blows, which were not on the vital part. In view of the fact that the matter stands investigated and challan though ready is yet to be presented and the fact that trial is likely to take some time to conclude, this Court deems it appropriate to allow regular bail to the petitioner. The instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal/surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case.
