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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.03 dated 03.01.2021 under Sections 379B, 341, 34 IPC, Police Station Badli, Jhajjar.

The prosecution case is that one Sushil Kumar got registered the present case with the allegations that on the intervening night of 02/03.01.2021 he was deputed as driver on vehicle No.RJ-32GB-5972 owned by Yasin Khan. Rahul Kumar Yadav was with him as Conductor on the said vehicle. They were on their way from Dadri to Najafgarh after loading stone-crusher. When they reached near village Gubhana, two young boys with muffled faces, came on a white motorcycle and got stopped their vehicle. They forcibly entered in the vehicle and snatched a sum of Rs.20,000/- and a mobile phone from the complainant. They also snatched Rs.4,000/- from Conductor Rahul Kumar Yadav after giving beatings to

them.

Ld. counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been falsely involved in the case. He was neither named in the FIR nor his identity was established. The petitioner has been behind bars since 03.01.2021. The complainant Sushil Kumar and eye-witness Rahul Kumar Yadav have been examined by the Trial Court and both of them have not supported the prosecution case.

Having considered the above submissions, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner Manjeet is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
