The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.348, dated 22.05.2020 registered under Sections 377, 506 IPC, 1860, Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, and Sections 75 and 82 of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition. Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Vide orders dated 14.10.2020 and 27.10.2020, this Court had directed the Superintendent of Police, Hisar, to examine the petition and submit a status report. In compliance of the said order a SET was constituted and a Comprehensive Report by way of affidavit of Balwan Singh, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Hisar has been filed.

A perusal of the report shows a very shocking state of affairs. This Court deems it appropriate to call upon the police authorities as well as the Department of School Education, Haryana to apprise as to the action taken on the basis of the report.

A copy of the Comprehensive Report be sent to the Department of School Education, Haryana as well as to the Director General of Police, Haryana.
