The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing as prayed by the learned counsels.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

On 08.09.2021, the following order was passed:-

“The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition has been filed by the wife seeking the transfer of the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/373/2021, titled as “Sukhwinder Singh vs. Jasveer Kaur”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Hoshiarpur, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur.

The petitioner claims that she got married to the respondent on 01.12.2019. She claims that presently, she is residing with her parents at Sangrur and the distance between Hoshiarpur and Sangrur is more than 160 Kms.

The petitioner further claims that she cannot properly defend the petition at Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner places reliance on the pendency of a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., at Sangrur. The learned counsel contends that it will be very difficult for the petitioner to travel on each date of hearing.

Notice of motion for 07.10.2021.

The liberty is granted to the petitioner to serve the respondent through his counsel Sh. Kulwinder Singh Saini, at District Courts, Hoshiarpur.

The facts noticed in the order dated 08.09.2021, remain uncontroverted. Hence, the application is allowed.

The petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, bearing case No.HMA/373/2021, titled as “Sukhwinder Singh vs. Jasveer Kaur”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Hoshiarpur, is ordered to be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 26.10.2021.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
