The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to
COVID-19 situation.

On 8.10.2020, this Court passed the following order:

*“This petition has been moved seeking anticipatory bail
in FIR No. 171 dated 2.9.2020, under Section 323, 324, 34 IPC
at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, Punjab, stating
that the parties have compromised the matter and an affidavit to
the said effect is attached as Annexure P-3 with the petition.*

*Learned counsel for the complainant supports the fact
that the matter has been compromised.*

*Considering the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is granted
interim bail subject to his joining investigation within two
weeks. He shall be bound by the conditions as envisaged under*

Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Kuldeep Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, the order dated 8.10.2020 is made absolute.
