Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondent No.2 to provide protection of life and liberty to the members of the petitioner and her family members and take action on his representation dated 16.07.2021 (Annexure P-2).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), Punjab to decide representation dated 16.07.2021 (Annexures P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed by the learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), Punjab is directed to look into the representation dated 16.07.2021 (Annexures P-2) of the petitioner and decide the same at the earliest preferably within a period of one month from today.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
