VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a criminal writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent no.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that respondent no.4 has given a statement that neither he has threatened the petitioner nor he will threaten her in the future. It is further pointed out that FIR no. 116/2021 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, has been registered against one Rahul Kumar (next friend through whom present petition has been filed by the petitioner).

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that since respondent no.4 has given the statement, thus, the present petition

qua the present petitioner has become infructuous.

The present petition is, thus, disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, the said order will not come in the way of police authorities to proceed against Rahul Kumar, in accordance with law.
