GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Balwinder Singh, stated to be aged 50 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 17.03.2021 (Annexure P-3), vide which the petitioner was dismissed from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the above said grievance, the petitioner has filed a revision petition to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, under Rule 16.32 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934, against order dated 17.03.2021, passed by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City, Amritsar and also against the recommendation of Joint Commissioner, recommending the dismissal of the petitioner from service dated 17.03.2021. It is further submitted that the above said revision petition

has yet not been decided.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Abhay Pal Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the peculiar facts and circumstances as noticed above and without commenting upon merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to decide the revision petition (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within **four months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
