The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.283 dated 16.08.2020, under Sections 498-A and 494 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute and the parties have arrived at a settlement on 10.02.2021 through the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

This Court, by the order dated 09.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from Sub Inspector Avtar

Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
