Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.34 dated 19.01.2015 under Sections 302, 34, 120-B IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Gurugram.

At the very outset, learned State counsel has submitted that out of total 36 prosecution witnesses, 32 PWs have already been examined and now the case is fixed for 07.07.2021 for recording statements of remaining prosecution witnesses.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that considering the fact that the petitioner is in long custody, the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, by giving short dates.

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After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the custody certificate dated 05.07.2021 filed in the Court today, wherein the petitioner is shown in custody of almost 03 years, the trial Court as well as the Commissioner of Police, Gurugram are directed to ensure that remaining four prosecution witnesses are examined within a period of two months from today.

Thereafter, the trial Court will grant two months' time to the petitioner to lead his defence evidence and will conclude the trial within a period of four months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
