The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Narinder Kumar, stated to be aged approximately 59 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release GPF, Gratuity, Leave Encashment and other pensionary benefits as well as complete pension of the petitioner on account of superannuation on 31.05.2019 along with interest @ 18% p.a. on account of delayed payment of retiral benefits of the petitioner.

Records of the case show that vide order dated 28.10.2020, notice of motion was issued.

Today, on the resumed hearing of the case, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he wants to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the recovery proceedings which have been initiated against him, in accordance with law.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Vinod S. Bhardwaj, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondents-PSPCL.

Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection if the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, is accepted.

In view of the above, writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
