Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.83 dated 25.5.2020 under Section 302, 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 and 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 29, 54, 59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar, Batala.

Vide order dated 09.10.2020 and subsequent order dated 18.11.2020, the petitioner has been granted the concessions of interim anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Sukhjinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required. She further states that the investigation is complete and challan has been presented.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed. The orders dated 09.10.2020 and 18.11.2020 are made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
