Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.211 dated 17.07.2020 under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 27.11.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage. Challan in the case has been presented in the Court and the case is now fixed for framing of charge.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 has opposed the bail application.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required and challan has already been presented in the Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide dated 27.11.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
