1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to approach the learned Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Kurukshetra, with a prayer for directions to the respondent to expedite decision in terms of orders dated 23.02.2021 in CWP No.4396 of 2020.

2. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.

3. In the eventuality of the petitioner approaching the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Kurukshetra, this Court is sanguine that the learned Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Kurukshetra would proceed in the matter expeditiously and comply with order dated 23.02.2021 in CWP No.4396 of 2020 in accordance with law.

4. Needless to mention, in case of non-compliance with order dated 23.02.2021 in CWP No.4396 of 2020 within reasonable period of time, the petitioner would be at liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law with to ensure compliance thereof.

5. Petition *disposed of* as not calling for any further orders at this stage except as noted above.
