The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing respondent No. 2 to release pension and other pensionary benefits to petitioner from the date of his superannuation, i.e. from 30.06.2016 alongwith interest at the rate of 12% per annum, for which, legal notice (Annexure P-7) has also been served upon the respondent authorities.

Heard.

At the asking of the Court Mr. Shireesh Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice (Annexure P-7) as representation of petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
